- \*Check out our teachers' Schoology page for the latest news and assignments found on the left side of your PowerSchool homepage.
- \*Call or email your child's teacher. Our teachers strive to return voicemail and email by the following day (Monday-Friday).
- \*Attend parent teacher conferences, which will occur on February 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>.
- \*Volunteer! Mrs. Wactor, Desert Sky's Volunteer Coordinator, is always searching for volunteers to work in classrooms, tutor students, help out in the workroom, or support staff at our various community events. She can be reached at 879-2011.

Dear Desert Sky Families,

I am writing to let you know that schools around the country are dealing with an increase in a dangerous new trend among students, e-cigarette use, also known as vaping. This trend has unfortunately found its way into our community and schools.

#### THE PROBLEM

E-cigarettes, vape pens, or juuls, are electronic devices that emit a vapor that is inhaled by the user and are often times undetectable due to how small they are and a lack of odor that is detected.

Students who are using these devices are inhaling nicotine and other harmful chemicals, thinking it is safe. Nicotine is highly addictive and some of these unregulated products that students are purchasing at vape shops, or online, contain higher levels of nicotine than cigarettes. Vaping devices are also being used to dispense crystallized marijuana (THC) and have become a common way for students to use marijuana concentrates (oil) which are four times stronger than high grade marijuana, which places students at risk for THC overdose.

#### POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES

In addition to safety concerns, we want to remind our students that the possession or use of a vaping device is prohibited in school, on school property, or at school events. Students found possessing or using these devices are subject to discipline under our school's Code of Conduct, which may include short or long-term suspension. Additionally, students found with these items many face felony charges from local law enforcement.
